2024 MN Prevention Program Sharing Conference

Student Conference Attendees will be expected to:

- Actively engage in conference sessions (ex. take notes, listen and/or participate in group discussions and networking);
- Approach conference content with an open-minded perspective and attitude of learning;
- Set personal goals and expectations about what the student wants to learn, gain, and contribute to the conference; and
- Behave in a respectful and professional manner at and between all conference sessions.
 - Be considerate and respectful
 - Communicate openly with respect for others, critiquing ideas rather than individuals.
 - Avoid personal attacks directed toward other attendees.
 - Be mindful of your surroundings and of other event attendees.

The conference will:

- Host a "Conference 101" Orientation session to orient student conference attendees to expectations, content, opportunities for engagement, and tools to get the most out of their experience;
- Provide opportunities for student groups and coalitions to engage with each other
- Provide packaged snacks available for youth conference attendees in the Weidner/Clarke/Edelbrooke Room all day (including outside of scheduled meal times) on Day One of the conference;
- Be responsive to requests for student accommodations and needs; and
- Set clear expectations and answer questions about student engagement.
